Summer break is an excellent opportunity for our students to nurture their love for reading and learning. At FCS, we believe that fostering a passion for literature and knowledge is academically enriching and also spiritually uplifting, as it aligns with our Christian values of seeking wisdom and understanding.

The FCS elementary school **Summer Reading Initiative** encourages our students to stay academically engaged during the break.

Here are the details:

Book Selection

- Students will receive a pre-selected book list for the grade level they will enter for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Students in grades 3-5 are required to select and read at least two chapter books from the list.
- For grades 1 and 2, students are required to read at least 4 picture books in June and 4 picture books in July.
- Students are encouraged to read as much as possible and of course more than the required amount of books.

Reading Log

- A reading log is attached for students to keep track of the books they read over the summer.
- Students are to return their reading log(s) to their teacher when they return to school in the fall.
- Students will use the reading log(s) to find the books they read in Accelerated Reader at school, in their classroom.

Reading Comprehension Tests

- Students will take Accelerated Reader comprehension reading tests on the books they read over the summer in Renaissance when they return to school in August.
- These tests will assess their understanding of the stories, characters, themes, and lessons learned.
- Students will test on summer readings during the first week of school with their teacher.
- Teachers will average students' AR test results; the average will be recorded as a **Reading Test** grade in the first guarter of the school year.

Purpose and Benefits

- The FCS Elementary Summer Reading Initiative aims to prevent the "summer slide" and maintain students' reading skills and comprehension abilities.
- Engaging with quality literature enhances reading proficiency, critical thinking skills, and overall academic preparedness.
- The carefully selected books will reinforce Christian values and moral lessons, fostering spiritual growth alongside intellectual development.

You can help your child's reading journey this summer by discussing the books, exploring themes and lessons together, and fostering an environment that promotes intellectual curiosity and spiritual growth. You may also consider having your child write journal entries and illustrate their thoughts about the characters, setting, plot, and main ideas with each entry can help reinforce their understanding and prepare them for the AR tests he/she will take at the beginning of the school year.

Enclosed is our book list; arranged by grade level with the book level (**BL**) following each title. Students are not limited to the books on our list. If students read a book not on our list, please be sure to verify the book is an **AR** testable book using the following link for Accelerated Reader https://www.arbookfind.com/UserType.aspx?RedirectURL=%2fdefault.aspx
